Does the "1000 years" refer to the whole of the church age or the final part?

Note 3. Typically believing that Jesus will come to join all believers (Jewish and Gentile) on earth; and establish His reign for 1000 years.

Note 4. See above; but that Jesus will "rapture" Gentile believers up to heaven prior to His reign on earth; i.e. Gentile believers will escape the Great Tribulation.

Note 5. Typically believing that the church will triumph through mass conversions prior to Jesus' return.

Note 6. Typically believing that the church will triumph prior to Jesus' return by having Christians control the political sphere; and that non-believers will defer to the superior wisdom of the church.
